- 1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior who resides in the American Legion Second District of Iowa (Clinton Co. Dubuque Co., Jackson Co., Linn Co., Jones Co. or Scott Co.).
- 2. It is not necessary to be related to a member of the American Legion or Auxiliary.
- 3. Applicant must attend college in the state of Iowa.
- 4. Application blank must be filled out entirely. Failure to comply will be automatic disqualification.
- Two (2) separate \$500.00 general Merit Awards will be awarded. One for each student selected.
- 6. The \$500.00 Merit Award will be sent directly to the student or the student may asked to accept the award at an American Legion meeting but only after proof of completion of the first semester of the freshman year and proof of enrollment for the second semester.
- The Chairman of the Merit Awards Committee will accept postmarked applications, with the students transcript of high school grades, and a personal letter up to and including March 31, 2018.
- These American Legion Merit Awards should not be confused with the Merit Awards or scholarships provided by the American Legion Auxiliary.
