

JONES COUNTY DAIRY PROMOTION SCHOLARSHIP

The Jones County Dairy Promotion Scholarship is for the purpose of assisting a graduating senior pursuing a post-secondary **agriculture-related** education in an accredited institution.

The recipient(s) must be a graduating senior from a Jones County school district. To qualify for the Jones County Dairy Promotion Scholarship, the student must:

1. Complete a Jones County Dairy Promotion Scholarship application
2. Submit a typed, 200 word essay in support of your application describing yourself and why you should be awarded this scholarship
3. Submit three letters of reference

The judging of the essay and application will be done by the Jones County Dairy Promotion Committee. The number of scholarships awarded and the value of the scholarships is at the discretion of the Jones County Dairy Promotion Committee.

The recipient of the scholarship will receive a check made payable to the recipient and to the school the student will be attending after providing his/her class schedule to the Jones County Dairy Promotion Committee. The scholarship recipient(s) will be notified prior to the Jones County Dairy Banquet on February 6, 2016. Recipient(s) are expected to attend the Jones County Dairy Banquet.

The recipient must begin studies within 1 year of the scholarship award. Funds are to be used only for tuition, room and board, or books.

Entrants must submit an application form, essay, and three reference letters by **February 1, 2016**. Send all application materials to:
