The Anamosa Board of Education met in regular session on January 4, 2016, at 7:00 p.m., in the Anamosa Schools Administrative Offices with President McKean presiding. Members present: Behnke, Riniker, Kilburg, Claussen, Sayre and Braden.

Motion by Behnke, seconded by Riniker to adopt the agenda, as printed. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Behnke, seconded by Kilburg to approve the resignation of Jill Elliott, Kids Club Director, effective January 15, 2016. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Behnke, seconded by Kilburg to approve the hiring of Angie Schwendinger, Kids Club Secretary, effective January 5, 2016. Motion carried 7-0.

Jacqueline Lahey, high school principal, presented ideas on the possibility of establishing an Alternative High School program at Anamosa. After hearing her presentation, it was the general consensus of the Board to go ahead with the plan and have her come back with a finalized version as soon as possible.

Motion by Behnke, seconded by Sayre to approve changes to the high school Program of Studies for the 2016-17 school year. In addition, a Personal Finance class will be added as a graduation requirement and one class (Computer Applications) will be deleted as a graduation requirement. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Behnke, seconded by Kilburg to approve the Heart and Solutions Counseling Agreement, as presented. Motion carried 7-0.
