

Anamosa Community School District
Regular Meeting
November 9, 2015

The Anamosa Board of Education met in regular session on November 9, 2015, at 7:00 p.m., in the Anamosa Schools Administrative Offices with President McKean presiding. Members present: Behnke, Riniker, Kilburg, Claussen, Sayre and Braden.

Motion by Behnke, seconded by Riniker to adopt the agenda, as printed. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Behnke, seconded by Claussen to approve the hiring of Wayne Lasack, Assistant Varsity Boys' Basketball Coach, effective November 10, 2015. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Kilburg, seconded by Behnke to seek bids for a "Leg Truss" bleacher style of seating with a concrete base and a "full deck" style of seating for the ball fields. In addition, the "interlocking deck" style of seating would be an alternate bid. Motion carried 7-0. It was noted the "Angle Frame" style of bleachers was ruled out.

Motion by Kilburg, seconded by Riniker to accept a gift from the Grant Wood Area Education Agency for a 20' x 20' building with the specific location to move the building, at the Middle School, to be determined at a later date. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Claussen, seconded by Riniker to seek quotes for a concession stand/restroom foundation package to include utility hook-up preparation at the Middle School ball fields. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Kilburg, seconded by Behnke to authorize the request to the SBRC for On-Time Funding Modified Supplemental Amount for Open Enrollment Out in the amount of \$166,153, and Modified Supplement Amount for LEP Instruction Beyond 5 Years in the amount of \$4,266. Motion carried 7-0.

Board Policy #508.6 – School Activities Reserved Time for Non-School Student Activities was discussed at length by interested parents in attendance, school board members and the administration. After several ideas were brought forward, it was the consensus of the Board to review the policy again at a future meeting.

Motion by Kilburg, seconded by Behnke to offer two GM/Bluebird 65-passenger buses (#1 & #15) up for bid. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Behnke, seconded by Riniker to adjourn at 9:39 p.m. Motion carried 7-0.
