
Anamosa Community School District COVID-19 Response 2021-22

Masks will be required on school busses per federal mandate - this includes transportation to/from all events. Students should provide their own masks as our supplies are limited.

Our staff will continue mitigation strategies through cleaning and frequently sanitizing all buildings and busses.

Individuals who test positive (or are symptomatic) for COVID-19 are required to isolate for 10 days.

When can students/staff return to ACSD?

Jones County Public Health strongly recommends household exposure quarantine based on guidelines below.

QUARANTINE OPTIONS AFTER EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

People who are fully vaccinated or who have had lab confirmed COVID-19 within the past 90 days of an exposure do not need to quarantine.

	interventions (NPIs*, a.k.a. mitigation strategies).	
	 If any symptoms develop, you should immediately self-isolate and contact the local public health authority and/or your healthcare provider to report this change in clinical status. 	
	*NPIs that can be practiced by individuals include the following: correct and consistent mask use, social distancing, hand and cough hygiene, environmental cleaning and disinfection, avoiding crowds, ensuring adequate indoor ventilation, and self-monitoring for symptoms of COVID-19 illness. These are also summarized here .
