Arriving and departing

The area behind AMS is for bus traffic only; the front for all other vehicular traffic.

Bike racks are located in both the front (to be used by 7th/8th graders) and back (to be used for 5th/6th graders) of AMS.

Please honor the pedestrian right of way in the cross walks in front of AMS. Before and after school are very busy times and your patience and defensive driving will help in keeping everyone safe.

The school day at AMS is 8:10-3:10. On early release days, we are out at 1:10.

Breakfast

Students expecting to eat breakfast at school should plan to arrive at AMS between 7:50 and 8:00 and enter the main doors into the commons. All breakfasts will be eaten in the AMS commons. Classes at AMS begin at 8:10.

Daily Announcements

Our secretary, Brenda Lehrman, will send out daily announcements via email for those of you who have indicated you'd like to receive them. You can also find the daily announcements on Infinite Campus.

Dress and Appearance

As parents/guardians are busy buying new clothes for their child(ren) for the upcoming school year, please keep in mind our AMS dress expectations (and also in the student handbook).

The pride and image of a school is reflected in the way students dress. The image of Anamosa Middle School is that of well dressed young people. Appropriate dress combines common sense and good taste in dress and grooming. Shoes must be worn at all times. You must be neat, clean, and properly attired. Unacceptable items include:

- 1. Clothing that is revealing in its design (halter tops, spaghetti straps, tops that reveal the belly or midriff, crop tops, muscle shirts, extremely short skirts or shorts, etc.) If you find yourself constantly having to adjust your clothing, it is probably unacceptable for school wear.
- 2. Clothing with vulgar, sexually suggestive language and/or gestures, stated as a double meaning, or other messages that are disruptive to our school environment.
- 3. Clothing which has alcohol, tobacco, or drug advertising.
- 4. Caps, hats,bandanas, hoods--staff must be able to identify students without the hindrance of a head covering. Students should not intend to hide their level of engagement under or behind a hood.
- 5. Sunglasses
- 6. Gang related items
- 7. Chains, cords, ropes, studded jewelry, etc. that may be used as a weapon

If dressed inappropriately, students will be asked to turn shirts inside out, put on a jacket or change, etc.

We are hosting a fall sports parent/student-athlete meeting in the AMS gym at 5:00 on Tuesday, Aug 23, 2022. Volleyball, cross country, and football parents and student athletes should plan to attend. A message from Activities Director Mr. Jones will be a part of this meeting.

Safety Drills

We will be conducting a variety of safety drills the first week of school and practice at other times throughout the year. This is not to scare students, but for us to learn how to respond if/when we have a safety situation.

Tours of AMS
